Evaluation process. Candidates will be evaluated first according to laurea mark, publications and preprints, CV and possible recommendation letters. The short-listed candidates will be contacted for an interview, which may take place via skype.

How to apply.

All files (except the possible recommendation letters, see below) should be sent by email to assegni@mat.uniroma1.it in PDF format and collected in a .zip compressed file (filename YOURSURNAME_assegno2-2012.zip).

If your .zip file exceeds 15Mb, then split your material and send more .zip numbered files (filename YOURSURNAME1_assegno2-2012.zip, YOURSURNAME2_assegno2-2012.zip and so on).

In Form A (filename YOURSURNAME_domanda.pdf) you should declare:

- name and surname;
- place and date of birth;
- permanent address;
- citizenship;
- enjoyment of political rights;
- possible convictions;
- DL, LS or LM laurea degree or equivalent (with mark, date and institution).

In Form B (filename YOURSURNAME_B.pdf) you should declare:

- if you are a PhD student with no fellowship (with dates of beginning and end of your course);
- if you had an Italian "assegno di ricerca" or an Italian temporary research associate position (and, in case, with dates);
- if you took a parental leave (in case, with dates).
